会议简介:

亚洲建筑国际交流会是由中国、日本、韩国三国建筑学会联合举办的每两年一次的国际建筑学术交流会议,会议的主旨是探讨东亚的建筑文化传统、现代建筑发展与传统建筑特色之间的关系、现代建筑技术的发展以及可持续发展建筑等。该项国际学术交流活动已由多边学术交流会议转变成有来自世界各国建筑专业人士参加的国际性会议。

会议时间: 2014年10月14日(周二) — 10月17日(周五)

会议地点: 浙江杭州

会议主题: 文化促进建筑进步

中日韩三国之间有着相似的传统建筑文化,同时在长期的建设实践当中,各国的建筑文化又呈现出不同的特征,产生了丰富多彩的建筑形式和内容。同样,在世界各国和地区也都拥有着各自独具特色的建筑文化传统。随着科技的发展,当代建筑在设计、材料、施工工艺等各个方面都发生了巨大的变化。但是,对于传统建筑文化的追求始终是负责任的建筑师在设计实践中的重要考量因素。这种追求反过来也推动着设计、选材、工艺等建筑实践活动方方面面的不断进步,形成了各国各地区新时期的建筑文化。本次会议以“文化促进建筑进步”为主题,通过与会专家学者的研讨,将就文化在促进建筑发展进程中的重要作用做出新的阐释。

Introduction:

The International Symposium on Architectural Interchanges in Asia (ISAIA) is a biennial international symposium co-sponsored by the Architectural Society of China (ASC) together with the Architectural Institute of Japan (AIJ) and the Architectural Institute of Korea (AIK). It has been successfully held alternately in China, Japan and Korea since 1986 and attracted more architectural professionals from worldwide.

The 10th ISAIA will be held on October 14-17, 2014 in Hangzhou, China and hosted by ASC. The Organizing Committee of ISAIA welcomes architects, professors, researchers, building engineers and students to take part in the symposium and contribute papers.

Date: October 14-17, 2014

Venue: Hangzhou, China

Theme: Cultural Elements in Architectural Advancement

China, Japan and Korea have similar traditional architectural culture, while in the long-term construction practice, the architectural culture of the three countries presents different characteristics and produces rich and varied architectural form and content. Similarly, other countries and regions in the world have their unique traditional architectural culture. With the development of science and technology, modern architecture has undergone tremendous changes in architectural design, building material, technology and other aspects, however, responsible architects still pursue traditional architectural culture as an important factor in design practice, and this pursuit in turn promotes continuous progress in every sector of architectural activity including architectural design, building material selection and technology, forming architectural culture under new period in every country and region. The symposium, with the main theme of “Cultural Elements in Architectural Advancement”, through the research of experts and scholars, will make a new explanation on culture as an important element in the development of architecture.

The theme includes 7 topics:

以下是论文全文格式:

请用 Word 文档 A4 纸 (约 210×297mm), 论文分两栏, 左右两边各留空 20 mm, 上下各留空 25 mm。于 2014 年 8 月 15 日之前提交至 isaiaipaper@163.com, 不超过两兆。

字数: 限定在 5,000 字以内或文图总共不超过 A4 纸 5 页。

字体: Times New Roman, 11 号字, 单倍行距。

标题: 14 号字, 加粗, 首字母要大写。长度不超过两行, 最多 75 个字。标题空两行是作者姓名、单位和国籍。

摘要: 摘要在作者信息两行之后, 不超过 200 字。

引言: 提出文中要研究的问题、内容和方法等。

章节标题: 一级标题用 1, 2..., 二级标题用 1.1, 1.2... 依此类推。一级标题用 11 号字, 二级标题、三级标题等用 10 号字, 向左对齐。

正文: 11 号字, 首行缩进两个字符。

公式: 公式应连续排列和编号, 前后各空一行。

图形、图表和图片等: 在正文一栏或两栏内插入图形、图表和图片等, 以 Table 1, Table 2... 命名, 依此类推。确保图形、图表和图片等内容清晰。

页码: 页码由出版商在编辑论文时设置。作者不用设置页码。

结论: 以最简洁的语言概括论文结论。

致谢: 感谢对研究提供资助的单位和个人、合作单位等。

参考书目: 若所引用文献只有 1—2 名作者时作者姓名全部列出, 如 Smith (1990), Smith and Jones (1992), 当所引用文献作者有 3 名及 3 名以上时, 只列第一作者, Jones et al (1980)。所列的同一第一作者同年内的文献多于一篇时, 可在年份后加 “a”、“b” 等字母予以分别, 如 “2001a”、“2001b” 等。以下给出一例作参考:

所有提交论文须为未正式发表过的文章, 稿件均不退稿, 请作者自留底稿。

论文经大会科学委员会审定通过后编入论文集, 并安排部分优秀论文作者在会上进行交流, 演讲语言为英文。

论文作者负责获得批准, 在他/她的论文中复制任何受版权保护的材料 (文字、数字以及图表等), 应在致谢部分中表达感谢。

若相关机构要求出版许可, 论文作者负责从相关机构获得批准出版论文。

通过提交论文, 每个投稿人被认为同意通过大会组织方将他/她的论文版权转移给出版商。

Call for Papers

You are cordially invited to contribute papers to the 10th ISAIA. Please be informed on the following instructions for preparing the manuscript.

Download the paper abstract on website isaia2014.chinaasc.org or www.chinaasc.org and send it to the email isaiapaper@163.com before Jun 1st, 2014. The authors of abstract acceptance will be informed on Jun 30th, 2014.

Full paper format instruction:

Please submit the paper to the email address isaiapaper@163.com before Aug 15th, 2014. The manuscripts should be submitted in Microsoft Word and must be smaller than 2 M Byte.

The paper is to be written in two-column format and be right and left justified. The text must be centered on an A4 page (21 cm x 29.7 cm) by leaving 20mm blank spaces on left and right margin and 25mm on top and bottom.

a) Length

Maximum length of the full paper is recommended in 5,000 words or in 5 pages of A4 size paper.

b) Type font and type size

The font should be Times New Roman. The point size to use is 11 points with a single line space.

c) Title

Type the title on the top border of the A4 paper sheet and use Times New Roman font with 14 point size in bold. Capitalize the first letter of every word. Title should not be too long that occupying more than 2 lines. Suggested maximum length of a title is 75 characters.

Authors' names should be placed with two line space below the title. Authors of different affiliations should be noted with different superscript numbers. Authors' affiliations should be placed below the author names with one line space, with the corresponding superscript numbers.

d) Abstract

An abstract should be provided 2 lines space below the last affiliation. The abstract must not exceed 200 words.

e) Introduction

Introduction should describe the motivation or purpose of the research.

f) Section and subsection headings

Number section (1, 2...) and subsection headings (1.1, 1.2...) consecutively and capitalize the first letter of every word. Use point size 11 for section headings and 10 for subsection headings. Keep section and subsection headings always flushed left. If any further subdivision of a subsection is needed the titles should be 10 point.

g) Main text

Use font size 11 for text. Start a new paragraph by indenting it from the left margin (and not by inserting a blank line), except under a section or subsection heading.

h) Equations

Make sure that placing and numbering of equations are consistent throughout your manuscript with the same style of your text. Leave one extra line space above and below the equation.

i) Tables and Figures (line art and photographs)

Insert them in the text and arrange them across one (82mm) or two (170mm) columns of the page. Number them consecutively with Arabic numbers, e.g., Table 1 and Table 2. Make sure the typeface is still legible after reducing them to the final size.

j) Page number

The page numbering will be done by the publisher after compilation of all the papers. Authors do not need to number your paper.

k) Conclusion

Conclusion should state concisely the most important proposition of the paper.

l) Acknowledgements

The acknowledgement for funding organizations etc.

m) References

The Harvard System is used. References in the text should be quoted in the following manner: Smith (1975) or (Brown and Green, 1976) or if there are more than two authors, Jones et al (1980). References should be listed at the end of the paper in alphabetical order by the first author's surname. If references to the same author have the same year, they should be differentiated by using 1980a and 1980b etc. The style should follow the example below:

Author, K. and Coauthor, T. (2001) Displacement based design methodology for steel frame structures. *Journal of Steel Structures*, 1 (1), 77-82

All papers submitted should not be published before and shall not be returned.

All papers will be reviewed and selected by the Scientific Committee of 10th ISAIA. The selected papers will be published in the proceedings and part of them will be presented at the symposium.

The author is responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce in his/her manuscript any copyrighted material (text, figures, tables). Acknowledgement of the permission should be made in the manuscript.

The author is also responsible for obtaining permission to publish the paper from any relevant authority if clearance is required by such authority.

Each contributor will be asked to transfer the copyright of his/her paper to the Publisher. By submitting the paper, it is understood that the authors have agreed to transfer the copyrights to the Publisher through the symposium organizer.
